Gold Medal- <i>beautiful golden marbled with red. Organic seed.</i>
Kelloggs's Breakfast- <i>orange, gigantic and sweet. Organic seed.</i>
Mrs. Benson- <i>an Illinois heirloom, pink and early, similar to Brandywine</i>
Striped German- <i>gorgeous, huge golden tomato with red marbling</i>
Tomatoes, Beefsteak
Big Beef- <i>large size and beautiful, early red beefsteak type</i>
Jetstar- <i>disease resistant and dependable red, medium size tomato</i>
Tomatoes, Roma Type
Amish Paste- <i>large and productive, organic seed.</i>
San Marzano- <i>Italian paste tomato for sauce, late, organic seed.</i>

Basil, Genovese- <i>old favorite, best for pesto. Organic seed.</i>
Basil, Amethyst- <i>purple and sweet, a superior variety</i>
Basil, Mammoth- <i>extra large ruffled leaves make for quick harvest</i>
Basil, Thai- <i>purple stems with green leaves, authentic in Thai cooking. Organic seed.</i>
Chives, Staro (HP) <i>edible flowers and leaves, organic seed</i>
Echinacea, Pow Wow Wildberry (HP)- <i>purple coneflower, easy improved native.</i>
Lavender, Ellagance (HP)- <i>early, uniform &amp; beautiful</i>
Lavender, Lady (HP)- <i>a hardy, dependable, early blooming type</i>
